This is our first newsletter from Gibson in Western Australia. Gibson is 25km from the beautiful town of Esperance.

We thank God for His Grace in our new move to this part of Australia. We also thank Him for all the help provided in settling in.

WHAT DO YOU DO IN GIBSON?

We are at a Christian Aboriginal Parents Directed School (CAPS) in a small country town called Gibson. It is 25km from Esperance, which is perhaps the commercial centre here. The name of the school is Wongutha CAPS. There are approx 70 boarding students. Most of the students come from areas around the Kimberley and Pilbara and some from the Goldfields. The students all live at the school.

Remy is the school chaplain. He also is a hostel supervisor for the boys. He looks after the spiritual side of the school, as well as help with the welfare side of the boys with three other male hostel supervisors. Theresa (I) tutors English two days a week at school. On another day she mentors the trainees at the school; helping them do their studies. This is with an employment service. She also works two days as a hostel supervisor for the girls.

NATHAN, NARELLE & GEORGE?

Nathan is still at James Cook Uni (Cairns Q'ld) and is happy with his studies. He still plays in the local Mareeba Rugby League team, though they have not started the season well. Nathan is fellowshipping at the Cairns Church of Christ and is very happy there. He is helping in the youth leadership and is growing in the Lord. We are thankful to the Pastors of the Church for their help in every way. Ps Albert and Ateca Viranatuleo in Mareeba, have done so much for him too, and we appreciate, what they are doing.

Narelle has settled into Esperance Senior High school. She has made friends at school. She has chosen to do aquatics and computing as options and is enjoying that. She has got on well with the girls at the school here and is happy. There are many times when she still misses her friends back in Queensland.

George is having another phase of adjustment and we need prayer. He travels on a school bus that picks Narelle too. This is at the school gate. He has an aide that is with him all the time. He has been enjoying this for the whole last term but going back this term has not been the same and we need wisdom.

We are taking the students with three other staff members to a Christian Convention in Pingelly, an hour's drive from Perth.
